

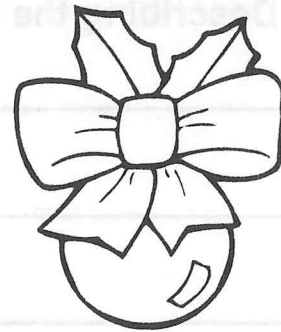


# Winter Ornament

**Teacher Note:** This report should be on a fiction book.

## Materials

- Winter Ornament Planning Page (page 101)
- item such as a tin can, plastic bottle, or Styrofoam ball to use as the ornament's base
- material such as paper, yarn, or cloth
- art supplies such as paint, colored pens, or crayons
- writing paper



## Procedure

You will be making a winter ornament to hang in our room that shows a scene or main character from the book you read. Use your Winter Ornament Planning Page to review words describing the setting and words describing the main character to help you think of ideas for your ornament.

Choose an item such as a tin can, plastic bottle, or Styrofoam ball to be the base for your decoration. Use paper, cloth, yarn, or anything else you can think of, to cover the base. Use paint, colored pens, or crayons to decorate the ornament in a way that represents the story.

This report will also have three written paragraphs. The first one simply tells the name of the book, the author's name, the publisher's name, the number of pages, and where you got the book.

In the second paragraph describe the setting in your story as well as you can. Make anyone who reads the paragraph see and feel the scene just as if he or she was reading the book.


In the final paragraph, describe the main character in a way that makes anyone who reads the paragraph feel like he or she knows the character.
