Progressive and Perfect Tense Verbs

Progressive tense of verbs

To make the progressive form of a verb, add the present, past, or future form of the verb "be" to the *present* participle ("ing") of the verb

Perfect tense of verbs

To form the present perfect, past perfect, and future perfect tenses, add has, have, had, or will have to the past participle ("ed").
