Be am is, are was were, been being have has had
do does did, can could shall,
should will would may might must.

Progressive and Perfect Tense Verbs

Progressive tense of verbs

To make the progressive form of a verb, add the present, past, or future form of the verb “be” to the *present participle* (“ing”) of the verb

Perfect tense of verbs

To form the present perfect, past perfect, and future perfect tenses, add has, have, had, or will have to the *past participle* (“ed”).

	Singular	Plural
Simple present	I walk you walk he, she, it walks	we walk you walk they walk
Present perfect (“ed”) (has, have)	I have walked you have walked he, she, it has walked	we have walked you have walked they have walked
Present Progressive (“ing”) (am, is, are)	I am walking you are walking he, she, it is walking	we are walking you are walking they are walking
Simple past	I walked you walked he, she, it walked	we walked you walked they walked
Past Perfect (“ed”) (had)	I had walked you had walked he, she, it had walked	we had walked you had walked they had walked
Past Progressive (“ing”) (was, were)	I was walking you were walking, he, she, it was walking	we were walking you were walking they were walking
Simple future	I will walk you walk he, she, it will walk	we will walk you will walk they will walk
Future Perfect (“ed”) (have)	I will have walked you will have walked he, she, it will have walked	we will have walked you will have walked they will have walked
Future Progressive (ing) (will be)	I will be walking you will be walking, he, she, it will be walking	we will be walking you will be walking they will be walking
